

NEW LOOK ON DRIVER'S LICENSE:

The Michigan Department of State is currently updating the security features found on their driver's licenses and State ID's. Completion of the phaseout of the current card format (with a magnetic stripe) is expected in early 2028. The back of the card will look like this:

LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill No. 134:

Changes DWI/Sobriety Court with "Specialty Court" to include, drug treatment court, DWI/Sobriety Court, hybrid of the programs, mental health court and veterans' treatment court.

Senate Bill No. 135:

Changes DWI/Sobriety Court Program to "Specialty Court Interlock Program". All driver responsibility fees will not longer be held in abeyance and will be due and owing at the time the individual applies for their Specialty Court restricted license.

Clean Slate Act Expungements:

Beginning April 11, 2023, some felonies and misdemeanors will be automatically expunged after a certain amount of time. This part of the Clean Slate Act requires Michigan State Police to make all expunged convictions within its database accessible to every court in the state. They will begin to notify the courts daily and securely transfer files of all eligible convictions set aside in its criminal history database. Please remember that all traffic offenses that cause injury or death, a conviction of operating while intoxicated, and commercial driver's license violations are excluded from automatic expungement.

Restricted Licenses

- Restricted licenses will be issued as a hard card photo license starting March 16, 2021. (Please see sample below). Because of this, they will need to go into a Branch to make application and get their picture taken.
- Restricted licenses issued prior to March 16, 2021, will remain a
 paper restriction license, also referred to as a green bedsheet. If an
 individual wants a hard card, they may go into the branch and replace
 their paper restriction license.
- Individual issued a 625G Permit will continue to drive on the paper license issued by law enforcement.

Use of Sobriety Court Inquiry through LEIN

- Courts using the Law Enforcement Information Network (LEIN) to process Sobriety Court inquiries will need to utilize their Direct Access accounts to process the Sobriety Court check.
