Application to Set Aside a Conviction (Also called Expungment)

If someone with a criminal conviction in the circuit court wishes to apply to have that conviction set aside, they need to complete SCAO Form MC227 – "Application to Set Aside a Conviction".

NOTE-Certain offenses cannot be expunged. A list of these charges is included with the instructions on the reverse side of the application. They may not apply if:

- They were convicted of a felony punishable by life imprisonment
- They were convicted of any CSC or attempted CSC.
- It was a traffic offense
- It is a HYTA case (because there is no conviction)

They may apply:

- 5 years after the date of conviction, or.
- 5 years after release from prison, if they were incarcerated for the offense.

After they obtain the form, they will need to do the following:

- Obtain fingerprints from the police agency in applicant's jurisdiction or MSP.
- Obtain a certified copy of the judgment.

NOTE: Include copies of both of these documents w/the copy of the application sent to the MSP.

When paperwork is filled out:

- It is filed in the Circuit Clerk's office.
- Applicant sets hearing date far enough in advance to allow return of report from MSP generally, you'll want it to be around 45 days.
- Applicant serves the Attorney General, MSP (\$50 fee), and the prosecuting attorney.
- Applicant files the proof of service with this office.

No one other than the MSP is to be given any information on a case once it has been sealed.
