Road to Restoration Clinics – MDOS is again holding Road to Restoration Clinics over the State in 2023. We have two dates confirmed: March 8<sup>th</sup> in Saginaw and August 12<sup>th</sup> in Alpena. We also have the following cities confirmed, just do not have the exact dates yet: Lansing, Downriver, Kalamazoo, Detroit, Iron Mountain, Escanaba, Marquette, Traverse City, Mt. Pleasant and Mt. #### **Restricted Licenses**

- Restricted licenses will be issued as a hard card photo license starting March 16, 2021. (Please see sample below). Because of this, they will need to go into a Branch to make application and get their picture taken.
- Restricted licenses issued prior to March 16, 2021, will remain a paper restriction license, also referred to as a green bedsheet. If an

- individual wants a hard card, they may go into the branch and replace their paper restriction license.
- Individual issued a 625G Permit will continue to drive on the paper license issued by law enforcement.



## **Use of Sobriety Court Inquiry through LEIN**

- Courts using the Law Enforcement Information Network (LEIN) to process Sobriety Court inquiries will need to utilize their Direct Access accounts to process the Sobriety Court check.
